Tips for Celebration Bermudagrass:



Watering: Keep soil moist, but not saturated until well rooted. Water accordingly for seasonal temperatures , best in early morning (before 10 am). Summer water use is approx 3/4 inch per week



Mowing: Bermudagrass that is maintained at the lowest recommended height will require frequent mowing and require the most maintenance, BUT will provide you with a luxurious carpet of pristine turf. Never cut off more than 1/3 of the leaf blade at any one mowing.



Fertilization: Apply balanced fertilizer beginning when lawns are 50% green (April or May depending area) at 30 day intervals through August 15th.

Weed Control: Apply pre-emergent after installation and then Routinely 3 times per year, MAR, JUN and OCT. We suggest Pre-emerging for grassy weeds annually once temps exceed 85°.
